


## cost of living pressures for young Australians aged 18-25

The latest headspace National Young people Mental Health Survey found housing and rent affordability are the most worrying concerns for young people.


## when asked to pick three concerns that need to be addressed most urgently:








## when asked about their concerns around the cost of living:





This data features as part of a <u>headspace submission</u> to the Senate Select Committee on the Cost of Living which makes recommendations to government around:

- access to, and out of pocket expenses for, mental health services
- the importance of investing government funding in vocational services
- the specific needs of migrant and refugee young people
- the need to identify and support young people not captured in unemployment statistics, and
- the need to strengthen financial support for low-income earners.
