What can you do to help?


There are certain situations in which staff may need to talk to someone about you without your permission.

Staff are legally required to report the following to the relevant authorities:

- Suspected abuse or neglect of people aged under 18
- A threat to your life or the life of someone else including use and/or possession of a firearm
- Missing persons
- If we become aware you have committed a major crime which hasn't been reported

Staff have a duty of care to report risk and safety issues and, where possible, we will endeavour to make any reports with you.

This could mean that information provided to us by you about these issues will be shared with other agencies as required by law.

- Keep any commitments you have been involved in making
- Let us know if you aren't feeling comfortable or would like to register a complaint

Information about your situation may be discussed at meetings by qualified health professionals but all personal information is removed to protect your privacy.
